Specification/supplier: The stone must be either a local field or river stone that you have sourced and collected yourself, or a sandstone tablet available from Robertson Memorials, 1 Rosewood Estate, Sheddopark Road, KELSO TD5 7PU Tel: 01573 224772 specifically for Hundy Mundy Wood.

Robertson's standard tablet is cut from Swinton Sandstone, a local stone, which can range between light green and a grey/gold colour. The dimensions are 50mm x 300mm x 200mm, on which the name and dates of the deceased will be cut. In keeping with the natural setting, no paint should be used in the letters.

- The responsibility for purchasing, setting the stone, the safety and upkeep, including repairs to any gravestone remains solely with the applicant and their successor(s) in title.
- We reserve the right to remove stones which do not comply with the specification or which present a hazard.
- We ask all memorial stone owners to be aware that memorials are placed at their own risk and it is their responsibility to keep memorials in a good, safe condition. We do not accept any liability for the making good of any damaged memorials.
- We reserve the right to lift stones which have been placed in the wrong location and place them in the position that accords with the Register Plan and Burial Register.
- All applications must be submitted to us for approval and all appropriate fees paid, prior to any works being undertaken on site.
- Applicants must give Leedam Natural Heritage at least 7 days notice before the memorial is placed to give time for the plot position to be identified and flagged.
- All memorial stones must be set into the ground so that no edge protrudes above the surface, placed at the head of the grave and the writing must face the foot of the grave.
